- 75 ECTS MSc programmes (1 full year): business-oriented
  - $\rightarrow$  With later possibility for 45 ECTS supplementary education
- MSc degree programmes for working professionals ("erhvervskandidater", EKA)
  > 120 ECTS part-time study/part-time work





MSc degree programmes for working professionals ("erhvervskandidater", EKA)

- $\rightarrow$  120 ECTS part-time study/part-time work:
  - $\circ$  Part-time study  $\rightarrow$  15 ECTS per semester
  - $\circ$  Part-time work  $\rightarrow$  min. 25 hours per week

### **MORE INTERNATIONAL MSC STUDENTS**

- Nationwide:
  - 1,100 additional international MSc studentships in 2024-2028.
  - 2,500 additional international MSc studentships from 2029  $\rightarrow$
- In 2024, we could increase our international (EU) MSc student intake by 40 students
- The intake of non-EU students (paying tuition fee) is still unrestricted

## RESIZING DECISION AU IS BASED ON THE POLITICAL AGREEMENT

- Graduate unemployment
- The overall consequences of the reform to the faculties (resizing, MSc programme reformation, new intl. MSc study places)
- New studentship supply (geographic resizing mostly AU Viborg) from 2025-2030

...As well as AU's ambition to remain a 'comprehensive' university with a wide range of BSc programmes and sustainable education environments.



#### SECTOR RESIZING AT AU AND NAT

- The intake for academic bachelor's programmes will be <u>reduced compared to the average</u> intake from 2018-2022, starting from 2025
- At AU, this means a reduction of 545 and around 200 students in 2025 equivalent to 13%.
- At NAT, Rector and the Senior Management team have decided to reduce our intake to 681 students in 2025 (eq. to -15.4%), which needs to be distributed at NAT BA programmes.
